Mayor David Thompson called the Council meeting to order at 6:04 PM on Monday, June 15, 2015.

Present were: Councilmen Adam Abernathy, Marty Crews, Derrick Mostella, and Charles Williams. Councilman Tipton was absent due to hospitalization.

Mayor Thompson asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the Council Meeting on June 1, 2015. Councilman Williams made a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting on June 1, 2015 and Councilman Crews seconded the motion, all Councilmen voted yes, motion approved.

Mayor Thompson asked for a motion to approve an upgrade to a 6 inch line in the creek during the ALDOT Hwy 11 project at a cost of approximately \$10,000. Fire Chief Mike Barry noted that the ISO evaluation has been moved to September 1 at the request of the personnel at ISO. The new service truck will be lettered and striped tomorrow morning. Chief Barry stated that the service truck will hold extra air bottles, ventilation fans, salvage & overhaul, the extra extraction tool, cribbing, rehab equipment for the firefighters which include a tent, fans, cooler, etc. The service truck will give us points towards our ISO rating.

Mayor Thompson asked if any of the Councilman had anything further to say. Councilman Abernathy said that All-Star season is in full swing and they are finishing up cheer registration but will extend football registration.
