Present were: Councilmen Adam Abernathy, Derrick Mostella, and Charles Williams. Councilman Tipton was absent due to hospitalization. Councilman Crews was absent due to family vacation.

Mayor Thompson asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the Council Meeting on June 15, 2015. Councilman Williams made a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting on June 15, 2015 and Councilman Abernathy seconded the motion, all Councilmen voted yes, motion approved.


Mayor Thompson asked if Department heads anything to say. Chief Dennis Matthews did not nor did Randy Thompson.
